Title: A32S– STANDARD CABIN CONTROL CHECK

GENERAL:

THIS EO A-25-025 COVERS ALL A32S REG. AIRCRAFT WITHIN CLH/LHX FLEET AND GIVES INSTRUCTIONS TO PERFORM A STANDARD CABIN CONTROL CHECK TO ENHANCE PAX CONVENIENCE.

For maintenance use only:

The standard cabin control check is based on SPM Task 25-94-04-01 "CABIN INTERIOR CHECK" and additional Cleaning Task acc AMM are effective.

ACCOMPLISHMENT:

General rules for the standard cabin control check

- The meaning of "damage" on the work description is always a clearly visible damage, which is visible at first glance. Minor damages (e.g. scratches) are acceptable during line maintenance. Repair found damage or open a DD if necessary.
- If function of seat, overhead compartments, lights or any other item is not given, repair or open a DD if necessary.
- If cleanliness of ceiling, sidewalls, PSU panels, overhead bins or any other item is not given, clean item.
- Remove all findings of chewing gum on seat cushion, backrest, armrest or carpet with ice spray or replace the affected component.
- All placards and markings require only a quick check because there is also a specific check of all placards with another interval. Only obvious damaged or missing placards and markings require replacement.
- If aisle carpet is in unacceptable condition, change aisle carpet or open a DD.
- During C-check change complete cabin and flight deck carpet in any case.

During cabin control check, pay special attention to the following items:

1. Flight deck seats condition and functionality at

- a. Armrests
- b. Lumbar support
- c. Seat cushion
- d. Backrest, recline
- e. Lubrication of seat rails
- f. Restraint system

Note: Pay special attention to any kind of damage. For replacement criteria refer to AMM task 25-11-00-200-002-A

2. Cabin attendant seats condition and functionality at

- a. Seat cushion
- b. Backrest
- c. Restraint system

Note: Pay special attention to any kind of damage. For replacement criteria refer to **AMM subtask 25-22-00-210-057-A**

3. Passenger seats condition and functionality at

- a. Armrests
- b. Recline
- c. Seat cushion
- d. Table
- e. Seat belt

Note: Pay special attention to any kind of damage. For replacement criteria refer to **AMM subtask 25-21-00-210-057-A**

- f. Seat pocket

4. Aisle condition and functionality at

- a. Curtain (Attachment points, velcro strips)
- b. Carpet

General:

The use of vacuum cleaners and damp cloth is acceptable. To clean instrument screens use antistatic wipes for instruments.

Caution:

Take extreme care not to activate any switches and pushbuttons inadvertently.

Cleaning:

Clean the complete flight deck desktop such as display screens, instruments, center pedestral, main instrument panel, glareshield and side consoles. Use the following material:

- Display: ANTI-STATIC INSTRUMENT WIPES P/N ALG/CR215
- Surface: SPRÜH-REINIGER 400ML P/N DIAMANT
- Dust removal: Brush 3 mm, Brush 30 mm

Caution:

DO NOT TAKE FILLED WATER BUCKETS INTO FLIGHT DECK COMPARTMENT!

DO NOT USE WET CLOTH TO CLEAN INSTRUMENT PANELS, GLARESHIELD AND SCREENS!

DO NOT USE DETERGENTS TO CLEAN INSTRUMENT PANELS, GLARESHIELD AND SCREENS!
